You can tell when you are over the top and on the downward slope, by asking yourself 4 _____ number of questions. Do you find yourself getting impatient or 6 _____ (annoy) with people over unimportant things?...If the answer to all those questions is yes, you had better 7 _____ (control) your stress, as you probably are under more stress than is good for you.

To some extent you can control the amount of stress in your life. Doctors have worked out a chart showing how much stress is involved in various events. Getting married is 50, pregnancy 40, moving house 20, Christmas 12, etc. If the total stress in your life is over 150, you are twice as likely 8 _____ (get) ill.
